Highlights: On the occasion of the **China Arbitration Summit** a **"SPANISH ARBITRATION DAY-Seventh Edition: ESG AND ARBITRATION. INVESTOR'S PERSPECTIVE"**, organized by Mr. J. Félix de Luis, will take place **in person**, in Madrid, SPAIN and **by Zoom**, on September 6.

This is the second year in a row that the **SPANISH ARBITRATION DAY** focus on the topic of ESG.

The event will feature a Webinar on ESG and Arbitration, analyzing the importance of the issues related to Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) Principles, in connection with Arbitration from the perspective of Investors, who are placing more and more importance on these issues. Financial Institutions are also taking a more active role in monitoring and influencing the ESG impact of their investments.





At the same time, greater scrutiny of ESG Principles by all stakeholders in a project may well lead to a array of disputes, e.g. from operator's duties to financing obligations, reporting and information rights, access to discussions with counterparties, budgeting, approvals and distributions and etc. Those disputes can be solved, either domestically or by international arbitration.

The Seminar will give a glance from different countries regarding ESG and the role that international arbitration can play in this space.

Spain is viewed by foreign companies, mostly European and increasingly also Asian companies, as a springboard for doing business in Latin America, and vice versa, for Latin American companies to get into European markets, and recently also into Africa, through Spain.

In short, Spain can play a triangle role in the field of international arbitration between Latin American and European countries, on the one hand, and between Latin America and Asia, on the other. For everything related to Latin America, Spain is a dispute resolution centre of the very first order. Spain could be a "natural forum" for international arbitration for those parts of the world.

Participants will learn about the latest development regarding ESG in Spain, Latin America (Chile) and Asia-Pacific (Australia, China and Singapore), and the eventual connection with international arbitration.





Who should attend: Legal practitioners including Lawyers, In-House Counsel, Arbitrators, Academics etc. who are interested in International Arbitration and Managers of companies with Spanish, Latin American and/or Asian element or an interest in those regions.
